GENERAL INFORMATION

CPS is establishing new College and Career Academies to offer more rigorous and relevant Career and Technical Education ("CTE") for students. The academies feature a unique, proven approach to preparing high school students for college and career success. Utilizing state-of-the-art labs, students are engaged in industry-focused technical instruction that supplements CPS' college prep core curriculum. As part of this real-world training, programs expose students to job shadows and internships, soft skills training, and opportunities to receive scholarships, industry-recognized credentials and college credit.

Students will be enrolled at the freshman level in fall 2010. Applications from current 8th grade students must be postmarked by December 18, 2009.

Available spaces for the College and Career Academies will be filled through a citywide application process. If more applications are received than there are spaces available, students will be selected by computerized lottery. Preference will be given to applicants with minimum 7th grade stanine scores of 5 in total math and reading comprehension. If not all spaces are filled by applicants meeting the stanine minimums, remaining spaces will be offered to applicants with stanine scores below 5. A minimum of 30% of available spaces will be filled by students who live in the school's attendance boundary or 2.5- mile proximity area.

Medical & Health Careers Academies and Law & Public Safety Academies have additional application requirements and selection criteria. To qualify, applicants must also (1) have completed 7th grade with a minimum 2.5 GPA in core subjects, (2) test at or above grade level on 7th grade standardized tests, (3) have 9 or fewer absences in 7th grade, (4) submit a letter of recommendation from a principal, teacher, or counselor (with this application), (5) submit a statement of interest (with this application), and (6) complete a student interview.

Applications must be postmarked no later than December 18, 2009. Acceptance and non-acceptance letters will be mailed to students during the week of February 19, 2010.
